Please mark your calendars.
- Visits to School: We have begun parent visits to school this month. This is always an enjoyable experience for you and your child. Please sign up if you would like to visit. Visiting days are Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri. **No visitors on Wednesdays.** We ask that you please make arrangements to leave all siblings at home. If you would like to bring in a healthy snack for the class, on your visiting day, please call ahead for ideas and to make sure there isn't already a birthday snack that day.

- Sickness: Children with questionable contagious illnesses should be kept at home. The start of colds and illnesses is the most contagious period. Do not allow your child to return to school until they can fully participate in the nursery school program. This means fever free for 24 hours without Tylenol.
- Birthdays: As your child's birthday arrives, if you wish, you may send in a healthy birthday treat for all of the children to enjoy at snack time. Please do not send in sweets.  
Fruits, veggies or mini muffins are great birthday treats!

Please Be Aware: When lining up early to drop off or pick up please be aware of the neighbors trying to get in and out of their driveways. Often they are blocked and parents will not leave a space for them to enter or exit. Also, if you see our postal carrier drive up behind you or next to you, please give her some space. She is not trying to cut in line; she is just trying to deliver the mail. Please remember to use caution when exiting the driveway as well.

Please send in a verification form to us when your child receives his shot. After Dec. 31<sup>st</sup>, your child will not be able to attend nursery school without one.
